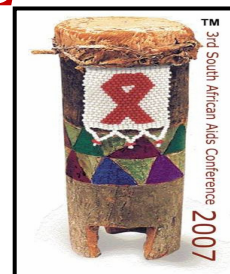


# 3rd SOUTH AFRICAN AIDS CONFERENCE

We invite you to participate in a round table discussion where a draft conference declaration will be discussed. This draft emanated from a pre-conference consensus generating meeting that took place on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> May 2007 in Johannesburg.

The consensus meeting focused on the following key areas:

- Prevention technologies: Male Circumcision, Microbicides, Vaccines, Female Condoms
- Positive Prevention
- Behavioural Interventions
- Long-term effects of ART
- Breastfeeding
- HIV testing strategies (including provider initiated versus voluntary)

The round table will allow dialogue on how the key national strategic issues relating to HIV and AIDS for South Africa can be implemented. The discussion will draw on the themes discussed at the consensus meeting. This roundtable provides a unique opportunity for stakeholders, communities and civil society to meet, discuss and reach agreement on the national response and concerns relating to HIV and AIDS. Come and be part of this great occasion. The debate will culminate in an endorsement and adoption of a declaration at the end of the conference.
